To Complete the Ranked-Choice Runoff Ballot:

1. Rank candidates in order of preference.
2. In the box next to the candidate, write 1 for 1st choice, write 2 for 2nd choice, write 3 for 3rd choice, and so on.
3. In each race, rank as many candidates as desired by giving each one a different ranking.
4. Choices from this ballot are collected and counted in the Runoff, if conducted.

Shall a total of not more than \$2,400,000 in aggregate principal amount of Webster County School District general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") be issued for the following purposes: acquiring, constructing, repairing, improving, renovating, adding to, extending, upgrading, furnishing, and equipping school buildings and support facilities and infrastructure in the Webster County School District useful or desirable in connection therewith, including acquiring any necessary property or demolition thereof, both real and personal, including, but not limited to (1) adding to, renovating, repairing, improving, and equipping existing schools and facilities including, but not limited to, adding classrooms and/or laboratory facilities; (2) adding to, renovating, repairing, replacing, improving, and equipping existing athletic, physical education, and playground facilities; (3) building, adding to, upgrading, and/or renovating the existing Board of Education office to include all necessary furnishings, fixtures, and equipment; (4) acquiring buses, vehicles, and/or transportation equipment; (5) acquiring real property (collectively, the "Projects"); and/or (6) paying capitalized interest and/or costs of issuing the Bonds; AND shall a 1 percent sales and use tax for educational purposes be imposed in the Webster County School District for a period of time not to exceed 20 calendar quarters and for the raising of not more than \$1,400,000 for the following purposes: (1) paying a portion of the principal of and interest on the Bonds and the School District's previously issued General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2005; and/or (2) paying all or a portion of the costs of the Projects?
